As the UN forecasts 500,000 displaced people due to the return to Taliban rule in Afghanistan, the adequacy of the Australian Government response deserves scrutiny.

Alarmingly, PM Morrison has said those Afghans who fled the country during the 20 years of war – and happened to come here by boat – will get no consideration of their claims for permanent protection. This means they are unable to secure safe departure of their families from Afghanistan.

In this newsletter you will find an **invitation to a Special Briefing on the legal issues for Afghan family reunions from Refugee Legal.** We invite you and our grassroots movement members of the Australian Refugee Action Network to join us. **Booking details are inside**.



## More than 120,000 people were airlifted out of Kabul airport after Taliban took control

## How many Afghans were evacuated?

The US-led operation to evacuate people by air has now ended, with the last flight taking off from Kabul airport just after midnight on Tuesday - a deadline agreed with the Taliban for foreign forces to withdraw.

More than 123,000 civilians were evacuated by US forces and its coalition partners after the Taliban took control of the capital on 14 August - but it's unclear exactly how many of those were Afghan nationals.

**The US has said that it flew nearly 80,000 civilians out of Kabul** and of those, about 5,500 were Americans and more than 73,500 were either Afghans or other foreign nationals.

While Canada and the UK have each pledged to take in 20,000 Afghan refugees, Australia has designated just 3,000 places in its existing humanitarian visa program which has room for 13,750 per year.

Priority will go to people with family already settled in Australia, women and girls, children and persecuted minorities like Hazaras. However, for those Afghan people who fled during the past 20 years of war and made it to Australia by boat, the Morrison Government still refuses to let them stay.
